Y.S.R Congress party

The Yuva Jana Shramika Rythu Congress Party (YSRCP or YCP; transl. 'Youth, Labour, and Farmers Congress Party') is an Indian regional political party based in the state of Andhra Pradesh. Its founder and president Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy serves as the state's chief minister.

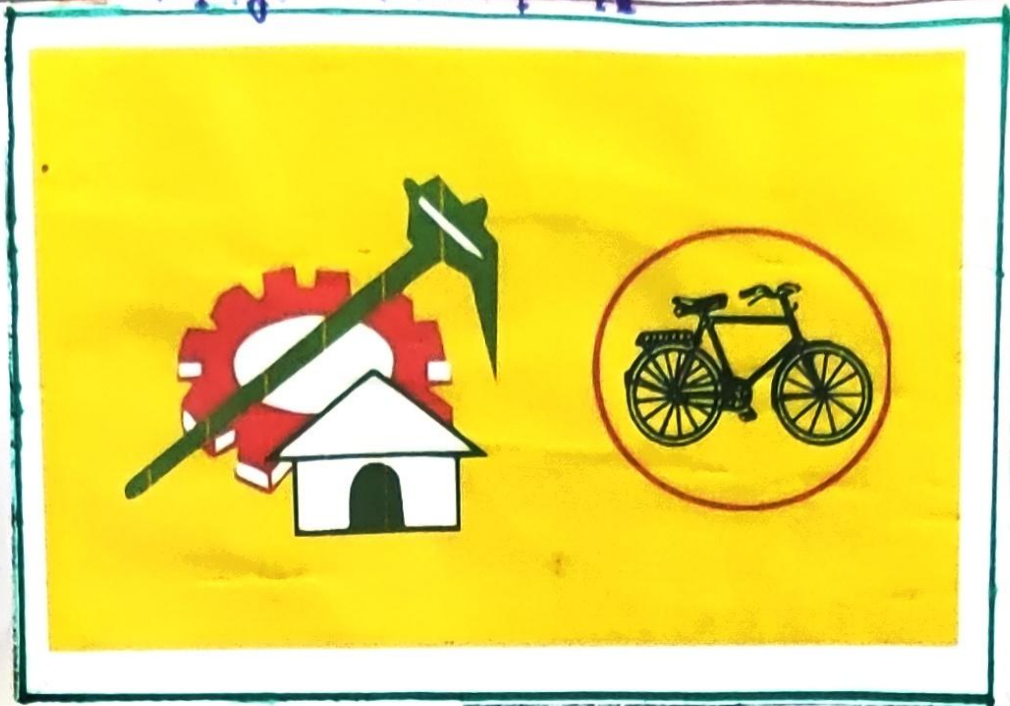


The Bharatiya Janata party (Indian people's party B.J.P) is one of two major political parties in India, along with the Indian National Congress. It has been the ruling political party of the Republic of India since 2014 under its prime minister, Narendra Modi. The BJP is a right-wing party, and its policy has historically reflected Hindu nationalist positions. It has close ideological and organisational links to the much older Rashtriya Swamsevak Sangh [RSS]. As of February 2022, it is the country's largest political party in terms of representation in the national parliament and state legislatures.

The Telugu Desam party [TDP; trans. party of the Telugu country], is a regional Indian political party active in the southern states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. The party was founded by N.T. Rama Rao on 29 March 1982. Since 1995 the party has been headed by N. Chandrababu Naidu, former chief minister of Andhra Pradesh. The party's headquarters is located at NTR Bhavan in Hyderabad. It is a party which has a strong presence both at state level and central politics. TDP espoused no specific ideology except for its commitment of safeguarding "the political, economic, social and cultural foundations of Telugu-speaking people." TDP was the first regional party in independent India to have formed the main opposition. TDP currently holds 3 Lok Sabha

Founded in 1885, it was the first modern nationalist movement to emerge in the British Empire in Asia and Africa. From the late 19th century, and especially after 1920, under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi, the Congress became the principal leader of the Indian independence movement. The Congress led India to independence from the United Kingdom, and powerfully influenced other anti-colonial nationalist movements in the British Empire. Due to its enduring history, the Congress is often called the "grand old party".

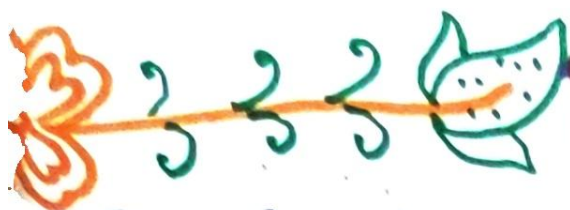
